What Is Valium?

Valium (generic name: **Diazepam**) is a prescription medication that belongs to the **benzodiazepine** class of drugs. It is mainly used to calm excessive activity in the brain and nervous system. - Tiredness
- Unsteady movements
- Confusion (especially in older adults)
- Slowed breathing (with high doses or mixing with other sedatives)

If any effect becomes severe, medical help is required.

Dependence and Warning

Valium can cause **dependence** if taken for a long period or in higher doses. Stopping suddenly may cause withdrawal symptoms, so doctors usually reduce the dose gradually.

Who Should Avoid Valium

Valium may not be suitable for:

- People with breathing problems
- Those with liver disease
- Pregnant or breastfeeding women
- Individuals with a history of substance misuse
